In 2017, it introduced an Honours Course in Education with an enrolment capacity of 30 students. Furthermore, the department organizes educational tours and invites distinguished scholars to speak on various facets of education.

TEACHING METHODS

- The Department of Education employs various teaching methods to facilitate the transmission of the curriculum to students:
- Lecture methods are used to introduce and elaborate on learning materials.
- Discussion and open question approaches promote classroom interaction.
- Flipped and Blended learning methods, including Flipped Blended Design, are utilized to encourage self-learning and advanced learning.
- Class Tests, both online and offline, are conducted to assess learning progress and identify areas of difficulty.
- Emphasis is placed on concept mapping and term paper writing to enhance topic understanding.
- Group activities and reference book reading are encouraged.
- Internet searching, YouTube video usage, and quiz competitions are integrated into the teaching-learning process.
- Practical work is facilitated through a cooperative learning approach.
- At times, the traditional Monitorial system is adopted to enhance capacity building among students.

Student-Centric Method

The student-centric method ensures students' active participation in the teaching and learning process. Experiential learning, problem-solving learning, and participatory learning are some of the forms of student-centric methods. The Department of Education always encourages students to be more active in the teaching and learning process. The department conducts tutorial classes where students are engaged in group discussion, debate, and class-based seminars as well as writing term papers and research proposals. Syllabus-related problems are created by the teachers, and students solve these problems through library work, collaborative, and cooperative learning approaches. Showing YouTube videos, Google Slides, PowerPoint presentations, and other online through the educational tour. Online tools and application software are employed for individual or learner-centric learning. Teachers in the department are engaged in students' soft-skills development, like ICT skills, personality development, and communication development. Students' seminars are organised to foster confidence and the expressive aspects of the learner. Intensive learner support was provided through face-to-face discussions with the learner outside of the class schedule. Class tests were given on a regular basis to evaluate the learner's learning progress and problem-solving abilities. Students are connected with the teachers through Whats App groups and Google Classrooms, where assignments and guidance are provided by the faculty members.

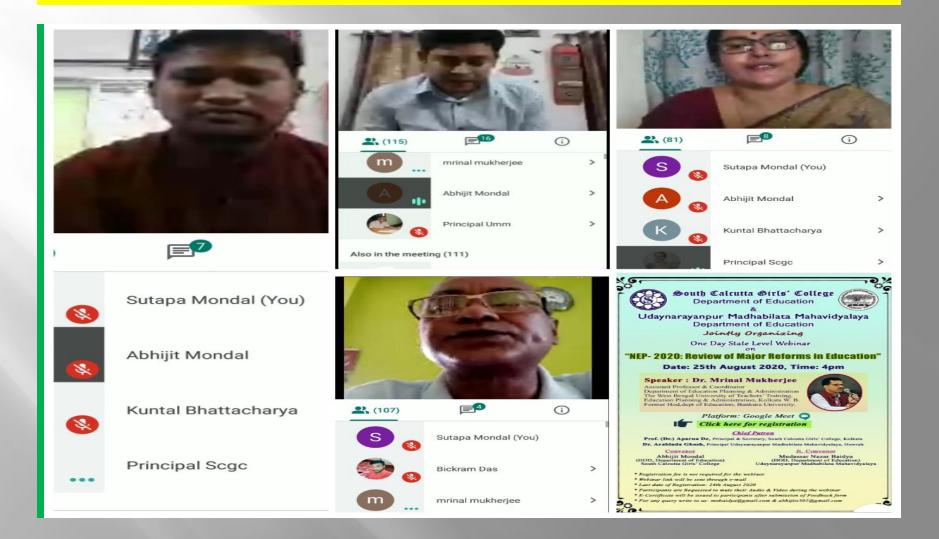
